- The last six months of 2007 have witnessed a 28% decrease in attacks compared to the first six months of the year. The 28% decrease covers July – December 2007 compared to January – June 2007.
- In the last seven months of 2007, each month the attacks have been down compared to the same month the previous year. That is a 20% decrease June - December 2007 compared to the same period in 2006.
