What is EN15713:2009?

- Have in place tested, secure and appropriate processes for the collection, retention and destruction of confidential material.

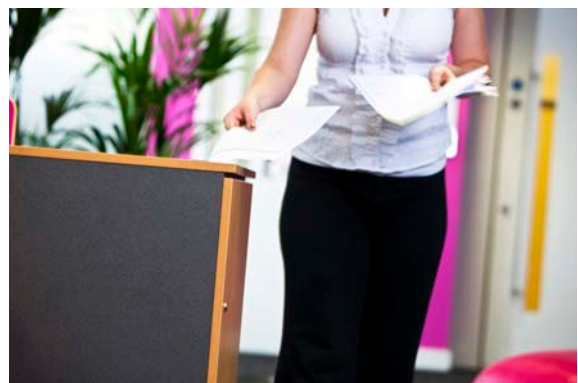
